

SWAT Introduction to Body Checking Camp 2010

Details are now available...

SWAT will be hosting its annual Introduction to Body Checking Camp again this year, which falls into the week of August 30th. It is a two day event, Monday Aug 30th and Tuesday Aug 31st (4:15 - 5:45pm) at Kinsmen "B" Arena. Please be advised, a Hockey Canada certified Body Checking camp/clinic is mandatory for all new players to peewee whether born in 1998 or 1999 and is a requirement to play in the Edmonton Minor Hockey Association. If you will not be able to attend the SWAT introduction to body checking camp, please ensure you have made arrangements to get it elsewhere prior to SWAT Peewee Tier 1 try-outs or regular Peewee evaluations, which will also be starting the last week of August, first week of September. (Remember, both 1.5hr sessions of the SWAT Introduction to Body Checking Camp must be attended for it to be considered passed and to have successfully completed the EMHA requirement.)

Players who can provide evidence of successfully completed a similar camp will not need to attend the SWAT Introduction to Body Checking Camp.

Goaltenders are not required to take part in a Body Checking Camp, but they would have to fulfill this condition prior to switching to a skating position.

It is important that we have an idea of how many participants will be at our Body Checking Camp, so we ask that you register your child's attendance by e-mailing a completed camp registration form back to Steve Whytock at player-dev@swat.ab.ca before August 20. The cost for attending this camp is \$40 and will have to be made payable by cheque to SWAT Hockey Association, prior to going on the ice for the first session. (You must have already been registered with SWAT for the 2010-2011 season to attend and season registration will not be accepted at the camp check-in/registration.)
